Submitting an Abstract – Guidance Notes

Your submission can be related to clinical or educational topics. All submitted abstracts will be assessed and ranked. The top six abstracts will be chosen for oral presentation, and the rest will be invited to display posters. Both will be judged on the day. If you wish to have your work presented as a poster only, you must specify it at the time of submission.

Abstract should include

- Title, authors (identifying speaker and grade), employing institution
- Introduction/Methods/Results/Discussion or Conclusion
- Abstracts should be no more than 300 words in length (excluding the title, authors and up to 3 references)
- A maximum of 1 table, a graph, or a figure can be included
- Results must be included in the abstract rather than "results will be presented."
- No smaller than Arial Font 10 point.
- Include whether your submission has been previously presented anywhere (this is generally acceptable, providing results are still recent)
- You may submit more than one abstract, provided all work is distinct from each other.

Please email the abstract as a **Word** document to Ms Jane Lee at admin@baoia.org by **5 pm on September 15th, 2025**. Late submissions will not be accepted.

All abstracts will be judged. The corresponding author will be notified by 20th September 2025.

Submitting an abstract confirms that the presenting author will register and pay to attend the conference by 26th September 2025. This is mandatory for the poster to be displayed or allowed as an oral presentation.
